

#### To the Landholder,

#### **Seeking Expressions of** Interest

Are you interested in helping to maintain the local koala population and increase the quality of their habitat?

North Coast Local Land Services (LLS) and the Hastings-Macleay Koala Recovery **Partnership** are inviting expressions of interest (EOIs) from landholders to enter into conservation agreements that will protect key koala habitat in the Port Macquarie Area of Regional Koala Significance (see map right).

Successful landholders will be offered different land management options, depending on the size and condition of your property. These will involve advice and grants to manage a conservation area on your property. Certain agreements will be eligible for discounts on Council Rates and Land Tax.

Conservation agreements will be developed with North Coast Local Land Services and the NSW Biodiversity Conservation Trust (BCT), guided by ecologists and bush regeneration specialists.

The Port Macquarie area supports extremely important koala habitat and a local population of koalas that is of state-wide significance. Landholders who participate in this project will be helping to secure this important koala population for future generations.













### Eligibility Criteria

- Your land is privately owned, freehold tenure, within the mapped eligible area (or not far outside the boundary).
- Your property supports a continuous patch of 10 Ha
  of native vegetation (or 5 Ha if adjoining a protected
  area). This area may be subject to further desk-top
  analysis to determine its value to koalas and other
  biodiversity.
- 3. You should be willing to relinquish any private native forestry agreements existing on the specific area.

#### Activities Eligible for Funding

- Weed control
- o Fencing
- o Pest animal control
- o Re-vegetation
- o Fire Management
- Habitat restoration
- Repairs to existing features, (eg. tracks) to maintain the conservation area
- o Native vegetation restoration planning
- Project / grant management support

 Applications will be assessed by an expert panel and site visits will be offered to the highest-ranking.

- We will work with you to identify the conservation area and develop a site management plan.
- Successful landholders will have the option of different land management agreements depending on the size and condition of your property.
- Land that contains high quality koala habitat will have the opportunity to enter into an ongoing agreement with the NSW Biodiversity Conservation Trust.
- Once agreements are signed, you will be eligible to receive grants to begin habitat protection works on your site.
- Successful landholders will be invited to attend workshops & technical information sessions on koala habitat enhancement.
