Stock watering place – lease tender process

North West & Western

A stock watering place (SWP) is a controlled travelling stock reserve (TSR), under section 61 of the Local Land Services Act 2013 (NSW), for which Local Land Services may grant a lease, under section 111 of the Local Land Services Act 2013. A Lessee must supply water (if available) to prescribed persons or stock, and allow prescribed stock to depasture at the SWP, under section 112 of the Local Land Services Act 2013. Note that recreation use of TSRs is not authorised in the Western Division, under clause 62(3) of the Local Land Services Regulation 2014 (NSW).

This document (Tender Process) sets out the tender process for determining the Successful Tenderer for an SWP lease that authorises grazing on the SWP specified in Schedule 1. This Tender Process should be read in conjunction with the Tender Submission Form.

1. Commencement

1.1. This Tender Process commences when it has been approved by Local Land Services and is published on the Local Land Services website at www.lls.nsw.gov.au/tsr

2. Lodgement of tender submissions

- 2.1. This Tender Process commences when it has been approved by Local Land Services and is published on the Local Land Services website at www.lls.nsw.gov.au/tsr
- 2.2. The lease fee offer in the tender submission form (Lease Fee Offer) must:
 - a. be unconditional,
 - b. be a single value (not a value range),
 - c. be exclusive of GST,
 - d. meet or exceed the minimum lease fee offer amount, and
 - e. be for the whole of the Travelling Stock Reserve.
- 2.3. The Tender Submission must be lodged electronically at www.lls.nsw.gov.au/tsr by 11:59pm (AEST) on 09 June 2023 (Tender Submission Close Date).
- 2.4. Tender Submissions lodged after the Tender Submission Close Date will be rejected.
- 2.5. By lodging a Tender Submission, the person (Tenderer) agrees:
 - a. to be bound by the terms of tender set out in the tender submission form (Terms of Tender); and
 - b. that Local Land Services may:
 - (i) disclose information contained in any Tender Submission to other Local Land Services and Departmental officers, consultants, and advisers as may be necessary to evaluate the Tender Submission; and
 - (ii) seek information as necessary from third parties and regulatory agencies in

- relation to the Tenderer: and
- (iii) make public statements about the Tender Process, including in relation to the Successful Tenderer and the Lease Fee Offer.
- 2.6. Tenderers must lodge no more than 1 Tender Submission per SWP.
- 2.7. Tenderers must tender for no more than 2 individual SWPs in the North West region.
- 2.8. Once submitted, the Tender Submission and all associated documents become NSW Government property and will not be returned.
- 2.9. A Tender Submission may be withdrawn at any time during the Tender Process by notice in writing to tsr.feedback@lls.nsw.gov.au

3. Review of tender submissions

- 3.1. Local Land Services will appoint a selection panel that will consist of one tender manager, two assessors, and one support officer (Selection Panel).
- 3.2. Tender Submissions will be provided to the Selection Panel.
- 3.3. The Selection Panel will review each Tender Submission and determine whether it is complete and whether it meets the eligibility criteria set out in the tender submission form (Eligibility Criteria). Note: The Selection Panel will aim to do this within 7 business days of the Tender Submission Close Date.
- 3.4. The Selection Panel will reject a Tender Submission that, in the Panel's opinion, is not complete or does not meet the Eligibility Criteria.
- 3.5. Before the Selection Panel rejects a Tender Submission, the tender manager will:
 - a. notify the Tenderer of the Panel's intention to reject and the reason(s) for rejection; and
 - b. allow the Tenderer 5 business days to rectify the Tender Submission.
- 3.6. If, after 5 business days, the Selection Panel is still of the opinion that the Tender Submission is not complete or does not meet the Eligibility Criteria, the tender manager will notify the Tenderer that the Tender Submission is rejected.

4. Assessment of tender submissions

- 4.1. The Selection Panel will assess and rank Tender Submissions from highest to lowest according to the following:
 - a. the dollar value of Lease Fee Offer (70% weighting); and
 - b. the Selection Panel's view on the suitability of the Tenderer based on the evaluation criteria in the tender submission form (Evaluation Criteria) (30% weighting).
- 4.2. The Selection Panel may request further information, at any time, by notice in writing from the tender manager to a Tenderer. The Selection Panel may reject a Tender Submission if the requested information is not provided within the period specified in the notice.

5. Successful tenderer

- 5.1. The Tenderer with the highest ranked Tender Submission is the Successful Tenderer.
- 5.2. The tender manager will notify Local Land Services of the Successful Tenderer.
- 5.3. The tender manager will give written notice to the Successful Tenderer advising that the person is the Successful Tenderer.

5.4. If the Successful Tender's Tender Submission is withdrawn or an SWP lease is not issued to the Successful Tenderer for any other reason, the tender manager will give written notice under clause 5.3 to the next highest ranked Tenderer. That person will become the Successful Tenderer.

6. SWP lease issue

- 6.1. If an SWP lease is issued, the fee for the SWP lease will be equal to the Successful Tenderer's Lease Fee Offer.
- 6.2. After an SWP lease has been issued, the tender manager will, by notice in writing, advise each unsuccessful Tenderer that they were not the Successful Tenderer.

7. Miscellaneous

- 7.1. Unless otherwise defined, words and expressions that are defined in the *Local Land Services Act 2013* have the same meaning in this Tender Process.
- 7.2. Local Land Services may, in its absolute discretion, at any stage, undertake investigations to confirm that a Tenderer has complied with the Terms of Tender, including to confirm there are no conflicts of interest which may preclude them from becoming the Successful Tenderer.
- 7.3. If issued, the SWP lease will be for a term of:
 - a. five 5 years (01 July 2023 to 30 June 2028) in the North West region
 - b. 14.75 years (01 October to 30 June 2038) in the Western region
 - c. and will be subject to conditions. Note: A sample SWP lease including conditions is available (see 7.7). Tenderers should be aware that it is a sample only and does not limit the conditions of any lease that may be issued.
- 7.4. Local Land Services may vary or terminate this Tender Process at any time, for any reason, by written notice on its website at: www.lls.nsw.gov.au/tsr. Note: For example, if no Tender Submissions are received, or if only one Tender Submission is received, or if no Tenderers meet the Eligibility Criteria, Local Land Services may choose to extend the Tender Submission Close Date, or vary, or terminate the Tender Process and consider other options for issuing an SWP lease.
- 7.5. Without limiting clause 7.4, if only 1 Tender Submission is under consideration, Local Land Services may directly negotiate with the sole Tenderer.
- 7.6. A Tender Submission that has been rejected is taken never to have been made.
