Certificate Set Aside Area Map	Set Aside Area 2	2.96	 The following revegetation requirements must be met within 12 months of the issue of this certificate: a. Native vegetation must be established and maintained at the minimum benchmark density for the vegetation community that likely occurred in the set aside area as follows: Overstory (trees) greater than 40 stems per hectare and Midstory (shrubs) greater than 10 stems per hectare; and A minimum of 50% native groundcover. The set aside area must be revegetated with native vegetation associated with Mixed Eucalypt Woodlands including but not limited to: River red gum (<i>Eucalyptus camaldulensis</i>) Yellow box (<i>Eucalyptus melliodora</i>) Inland Grey box (<i>Eucalyptus microcarpa</i>) Fuzzy box (<i>Eucalyptus conica</i>) River Sheoak (<i>Casuarina cunninghamiana</i>) Wilga (<i>Geijera parviflora</i>) Wilga (<i>Geijera parviflora</i>) Native vegetation is to be established and managed to improve condition of the vegetation towards benchmark condition.
