





## What projects are you interested in to improve your farm?





Northern Tablelands Local Land Services is developing projects with support from the NSW and Australian Government to invest in the long term sustainability of agricultural businesses in the region. We would like landholders to submit Expressions of Interest to help us identify and support their natural resource priorities on-farm.

Expressions of Interest will be assessed as they are received against a set of criteria including funding availability, landholder contribution, NSW and Australian Government priorities and value for money. It is expected that proposed projects would be delivered in the 2018/19 financial year.



Funding is available for on-ground projects that achieve improved natural resource management on farm.



- Protecting and improving waterways
- Providing alternate water points where stock are excluded from water sources
- Planting shelter belts or wind breaks with native trees or shrubs (must be at least 1ha in size)
- Improving habitat for threatened species

Funding is for on-ground works only

- Protecting and managing existing native vegetation
- Revegetation on-farm (must be at least 1ha in size)
- Soil management activities
- Activities to adapt to changing seasonal conditions



Please note that work completed before or at the time of project proposal is not eligible for funding

## Who is eligible for funding?

Individual landholders in the Northern Tablelands Local Land Services region

The Northern Tablelands Local Land Services region is defined as within the Tenterfield, Glen Innes Severn, Inverell, Armidale Regional, Uralla and Walcha Shires.

Applicants must make an equal or greater contribution (in-kind or financial) for every dollar contributed to the project.
