Stock Watering Place (SWP) lease tenders – 2020 to 2023

Information sheet

Tenders are invited for STOCK WATERING PLACE (SWP) leases in the Western Local Land Services region, for a lease from 20 April 2020 to 30 September 2023.

Information:

- 1. Tenders open 8:30am Monday 09 March 2020 and close 4:30pm Friday 03 April 2020.
- 2. Lease bids are for annual rent on an SWP.
- 3. Bids must be on the approved form (one form per SWP) and no verbal offers will be accepted.
- 4. Bids are for SWP rent per Annum.
- 5. SWP rent will be charged yearly in advance (in May for the first part year, then July/August) and subject to GST.
- 6. CPI increases will be applied annually to all SWP leases.
- 7. There is no recommended minimum tender price.
- 8. An annual administration fee of \$200 (excluding GST) will be charged.
- 9. Tenders will only be accepted for the permitted uses of grazing and watering of livestock; or conservation.
- 10. The highest bid or any tender may not necessarily be accepted.
- 11. Awarding of the lease will be based on factors including highest tender submitted, and previous payment and management history.
- 12. Non-adjoining landholders who reside more than 50 km by road from the SWP applied for may not be considered, unless they have an onsite manager or submit a written management plan that is accepted by the assessment panel.
- 13. Where determined under the *Native Title Act 1993*, non-exclusive Native Title Holders must be allowed to have reasonable access to the SWP for the purposes of cultural activities.

- 15. Do <u>not</u> enclose any money.
- 16. SWP leases are financially aligned to the fiscal year.
- 17. All tenderers will be notified, in writing within 20 business days of finalisation.
- 18. Refer to the lease documents for further information, including terms and conditions.
- 19. Authorised Officers will periodically inspect SWPs to ensure compliance with SWP lease agreement conditions.
- 20. NOTE: Some SWPs have changed names.
